MONTGOMERY COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The Montgomery County Public Works Association will make a scholarship award(s) as funds become available to students to assist with the cost of attending a trade school or institution of higher learning in order to obtain a degree or certification in a field relevant to the public works profession. For the purpose of this program, "Public Works" involves the administration, design, inspection, construction and maintenance of facilities and structures in and relating to property in the public domain or right of way. These include the areas of water and wastewater pipes and facilities, flood control, street pavements and transportation, sidewalks, street lights, refuse management, snow removal and equipment and building maintenance, etc. One or more awards may be made per year.

ELIGIBILITY

The applicant must be a resident of Montgomery County and be registered in a trade school or accredited college or university whose major encompasses the fields of Civil or Environmental Engineering, Public Works Administration or other programs within the public works field and intends to pursue a career in the public works field. The determination of eligibility shall be at the sole discretion of the Scholarship Committee. All applicants must be sponsored by a MCPWA member in good standing.

APPLICATION

The applicant shall submit a letter to the Scholarship Committee requesting consideration by MCPWA, including:

- Name, Address and Member Sponsor
- Description of the major or field of study; type of degree or certification sought.
- Proof of registration and a copy of a current transcript, report card or course descriptions.
- Start date of education or training and anticipated completion date.

REVIEW COMMITTEE

The MCPWA Board of Directors shall appoint a Scholarship Committee Chairman and review committee of three members to review all applications.

REVIEW PROCESS

If funds are available for any given year, the application period shall be from March 1st to May 7th. The chairman will announce the availability of funding and then receive and number all applications. He/she will then pass on photocopies of all applications with personal identity information removed to the committee. The committee shall make a recommendation for award, by application number for action at the July Board of Directors' meeting. The full board shall vote on the recommendation of the Scholarship Committee. The vote of the Board shall be final. Following the Board's action, the Scholarship Committee Chairman shall reveal the names of the successful applicant(s).

NOTIFICATION AND PAYMENT

The successful applicant(s) shall be notified in writing by the MCPWA. The treasurer shall forward a check to the successful applicant's school. It will be the responsibility of the applicant to provide the treasurer with the address, phone and point of contact at the institution's billing and registration office. The unsuccessful applicant(s) shall be notified in writing by the Scholarship Committee Chairman. Public announcement of successful awards shall be made at the July General Membership meeting.
