Seminar Titles: Special Member Request – How to Read a Traffic Signal Permit Plan

This workshop will review how to read and understand a PennDOT traffic signal permit plan including movement, sequence and timing diagrams, signal coordination, detection modes such as loops, video and radar, and traffic volume/density. It will also explain signal memory modes, dilemma zone protection, and what signs and pavement markings municipalities are required to maintain.

Please note: This program is not intended as a “hands on” training to learn how to maintain the inside of the traffic signal controller cabinets. Municipal employees should be trained/certified to industry standards in order to perform signal maintenance safely and effectively. The instructor will discuss the recommended certifications and training requirements for traffic signal controller maintenance.
